White Wines

- 1 **Villa Rossi Trebbiano, Del Rubicone** *bottle 22.75*
Emilia-Romagna, Italy 175ml 6.30 250ml 8.00
This easy drinking wine is made from one of the best loved grape from the centre of Italy. Dry, crisp and fruity with nutty aromas.
- 2 **Mannara Pinot Grigio** *bottle 25.50*
Sicilia IGT, Italy 175ml 7.00 250ml 9.10
The nation's favourite with a twist! Elegant and fresh with some citrus character.
- 3 **Arkeno Sauvignon Blanc** *bottle 24.65*
Valle Central, Chile 175ml 6.75 250ml 8.75
The classic Chilean style Sauvignon Blanc. Flavoursome and full of tropical fruits
- 4 **Deakin Estate Chardonnay** *bottle 30.25*
Victoria, Australia 175ml 7.75 250ml 10.10
Only the best in-house grapes are used from this vineyard named in honour of a former Australian Prime Minister, Alfred Deakin.
- 5 **Feudo Arancio Grillo, Sicilia** *bottle 30.00*
Sicily, Italy
This new trendy grape has everything. Rich and aromatic all-rounder wine, work with very well with seafood, white meats, pasta dishes and baked fish.
- 6 **Regaleali Bianco, Tasca** 35.00
Sicily, Italy
Delicately fruity nose with apple, peach and pink grapefruit notes. The palate is quite intense and crisp, with plenty of fresh fruit flavours.
- 7 **Pecorino Vellodoro, Umani Ronchi** *bottle 38.50*
Abruzzo, Italy
Refreshing, light-to-medium-bodied - combining tangy green apple with hints of herbs, stones and almonds. The lively acidity lifts the palate, leading to a clean finish.
- 8 **Gavi di Gavi La Meirana** *bottle 47.50*
Piedmont, Italy
The second best-selling Italian white grape varietal in England... If you like your wines dry and crisp with texture, no need to look elsewhere. Great with seafood and tomato based dishes.
- 9 **Bramito Chardonnay, Castello della Sala, Antinori** *bottle 60.00*
Umbria IGT, Italy
The baby brother of the iconic Cervaro della Sala is an exceptional wine in its own right. It annually runs out of stock due to popular demand. First come first served, now's your chance!
- 10 **Spinyback Sauvignon Blanc, Nelson** *bottle 37.95*
South Island, New Zealand
This characterful grape from southern Italy gives a rich, peachy style balanced by a lively citrus crispness.

Please note that 125ml measures are available upon request for wines by the glass.

Red Wines

- 11 **Villa Rossi Sangiovese, Del Rubicone** *bottle 22.75*
Emilia-Romagna, Italy 175ml 6.30 250ml 8.00
Made from the classic Chianti grape. Smooth and easy drinking.
- 12 **Terre del Noce Merlot** *bottle 25.95*
Vigneti delle Dolomiti IGT, Italy 175ml 7.75 250ml 9.10
Plum, red cherry with a hint of chocolate. A great value Merlot from Mezzacorona, the European winery of the year 2016!
- 13 **Angelo Montepulciano d'Abruzzo** *bottle 27.50*
Abruzzi, Italy 175ml 7.40 250ml 9.60
A super juicy classic. Smooth and round.
- 14 **Norton Porteño Malbec** *bottle 30.50*
Mendoza, Argentina 175ml 7.95 250ml 10.40
In 1895, everyone thought that Englishman Edmund Norton was mad to stay in Argentina to make wine. Here we are now looking at a world renowned winery!
- 15 **Silenzi Rosso, Pala** *bottle 34.75*
Sardinia, Italy
Intense, persistent aromas dominated by red fruit notes. Well-structured with a soft, plummy palate.
- 16 **Conde Valdemar Rioja, Crianza** *bottle 39.75*
Rioja, Spain
Complex aromas of ripe black berries balanced with warm vanilla notes and a touch of subtle spice. Excellent, rounded structure on the palate with aromatic complexity lasting through to the finish.
- 17 **Pèppoli Chianti Classico** *bottle 51.00*
Tuscany, Italy
Chianti is made by many but few are made by the master Marchesi Antinori, AKA 'The King of Sangiovese'. Find out how he got his name! Perfect with red meat and tomato based dishes.
- 18 **Tormaresca NéPriCa, Primitivo** *bottle 39.75*
Puglia IGT, Italy
Red fruits, black cherry and notes of liquorice. The palate is well-rounded, with soft, supple tannins and a pleasingly fresh finish.
- 19 **Costasera Amarone Classico, Masi** *bottle 87.50*
Veneto, Italy
Another beautiful example of 'Mister Amarone' talent. Masi reintroduced the technique 50 years ago but still no one managed to catch up!
- 20 **Brunello di Montalcino Pian delle Vigne, Antinori** *bottle 92.00*
Tuscany, Italy
Complex, generous nose with ripe aromas of cherries and raspberries, light tobacco notes and hints of coffee and cocoa powder. Multi-layered structure with a nicely rounded texture and elegant fruit leading to a very long finish.
- 21 **Pinot Noir Spinyback Nelson** *bottle 45.50*
South Island, New Zealand
Black cherry and red berry aromas are followed by succulent red fruit on the palate. The tannins are soft and support the bright fruit, with subtle spices.
